## **SOBER LIVING**

Sober Living is a shared housing arrangement for people who are working on recovery. It is often paired with intensive outpatient or regular outpatient treatment programs to improve the likelihood of recovery. It is often a good option for people who would prefer residential treatment but whose insurance does not cover residential. It is not a licensed service so Shasta County does not include a list here of available sober living homes. An internet search for "Sober Living Shasta County" will list sober living homes in the area. Another good source of information is the Residential and Outpatient treatment providers on this list.

## **SUPPORT MEETINGS**

When trying to address your addiction, support meetings can be an invaluable source of guidance, assistance, and encouragement. Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous, and Celebrate Recovery are examples of support meetings. Meetings are helpful, not only in maintaining sobriety, but also as a safe place to get support and discuss challenges. Support meetings are not treatment but are a component of a well-rounded treatment program. An internet search for "AA meetings Redding" or "Celebrate Recovery Shasta" will give you up-to-date information on meeting dates and times.
