


Map to Justice Center





Judges and Court staff wish to welcome you to the Superior Court. It is the Court's objective to make our services and facilities available and easily accessible to everyone.

Because the Superior Court would like to make your visit as pleasant as possible, it is our goal to administer justice in an effective, efficient, and professional manner. Please ask for assistance or accommodation if you are having any difficulties using our facilities, and we will do our best to assist you.

Americans with Disabilities Act

The ADA provides that no individual with a disability shall, on the basis of disability, be excluded from participation in or be denied admission or access to the benefits of the services, programs, or activities of the Superior Court.

All service animals are welcome in Court facilities. The ADA defines a service animal as any guide dog, signal dog, or other animal individually trained to provide assistance to an individual with a disability.

Courthouse Facilities

In order to preserve the safety of our employees and visitors, all members of the public are required to enter and exit the



building through the security screening station, which is located at the front entrance

of the courthouse on Court Street. There is a wheelchair ramp leading to this entrance.

The first floor of the courthouse includes the offices of Human Resources, Family Law Facilitator, Family Court Services, Information Technology, Juvenile, Appeals, and Jury Services.

The second and third floors of the courthouse include courtrooms and court offices (refer to map on back of this brochure).

The Law Library and snack bar are located in the basement of the main courthouse.



There are wheelchair accessible service windows in all Court offices. There are also two elevators located on the first and second floors in the courthouse that are wheelchair accessible. The basement has one elevator that is wheelchair accessible.

Telephones



Public pay telephones are located on the second and third floors of the courthouse. You may call the courthouse TDD by calling **225-5318**.

In addition, communication may be accomplished through the California Relay System, Speech-to-Speech Program, by calling **1-800-854-7784**.



American Sign Language interpreters are available to assist

you for court appearances or jury service by calling **225-5301**.

Assistive Listening Devices, for use in the courtrooms, are also available by contacting the Marshal's Office.

Additional accommodations may be requested by completing the form "Request for Accommodations by Persons with Disabilities." This form is available in all Court offices or from the ADA Coordinator. It may also be accessed by visiting the Court's Web site at www.shastacourts.com. First select "Self Help" and at the "Self-Help Center" page, select "Forms and Instructions." From there, follow the instructions.

Parking



Parking spaces for persons with disabilities are located on Yuba Street, which is off of Court Street on the south side of the courthouse.

Justice Center

Department 1 and Department 2 courtrooms are located in the Justice Center, which is across the parking lot on the West Street side of the courthouse. It is also adjacent to the jail. There is a wheelchair ramp leading to the entrance. There are no public telephones available in the Justice Center.
