Proposed Rule Changes
Effective January 1, 2026

Effective immediately, the proposed amendments to the Local Rules of Court for the Superior Court of California, County of Shasta are being submitted for comment pursuant to the applicable provisions of California Rules of Court, Rule 10.613, and are posted on the court's website (www.shasta.courts.ca.gov). The open comment period will end at 5:00 p.m. on November 16, 2025. The Court will convene to consider adoption of the amendments mid-November for a January 1, 2026, effective date. RULE 2.18 RECORDING DEVICES IN THE COURTHOUSE BY NON-MEDIA

No videotaping, photographing, electronic recording, broadcasting or streaming of any kind is permitted by individuals in any part of the courthouse, including but not limited to the courtrooms, all interior spaces of the courthouse, and its entrances and exits. Violation of this rule may result in the confiscation of the device used to video, photograph or record, and may be the basis for a citation for contempt of court or an order imposing monetary or other sanctions as provided by law. Except as permitted pursuant to California Rules of Court Rule 1.150.
