Here, Ms. McMaster and Ms. Buter have disclaimed their interest, therefore their intestate heirs are now intestate heirs of the decedent and are entitled to notice of these proceedings. If the intent is for the decedent's estate to pass solely to Ms. Ives, the intestate heirs of Ms. McMaster and Ms. Buter may file an assignment of their interest.

The intestate heirs of Ms. McMaster and Ms. Buter have not been identified, therefore the Court is unable to determine if proper notice has been provided and the accounting properly waived. The matter is continued to **Monday, June 15, 2026, at 2:30 p.m. in Department 44** for further proceedings regarding the Report of Executor and Petition for Final Distribution on Waiver of Account.
